Checklist for Homeowners During

| Wildfire Season | |

| Before a wildfire | |

| Landscape home regularly. Clean gutters and roof, removing all debris. |

| Relocate firewood at least 30 feet from home. |
| Securing external property during a wildfire |
| Gather flammable items, bring inside or place items into your poo |
| Turn off propane tanks and move propane bbqs and common combustibles away from structure (wood piles, patio furniture, door mats). |
| Move flammable vegetation (e.g. rosemary, juniper, bark mulch) away from structure. |
| Connect garden hoses to outside water valve and keep sprinklers off. |
| If possible, leave a ladder nearby for roof access. |
| Leave interior and exterior home lights on. |
| Preparing interior of home during a wildfire |
| Seal attic and ground vents with plywood or commercial seals. |
| Close windows and doors, leave unlocked. Remove window coverings. Close metal shutters. |
| Move furniture from windows and doors. |
| Shut off gas at meter and turn off pilot lights. |
| Turn off air conditioner. |
| In the event of evacuation |
| Back car into driveway, with vehicle loaded with emergency |
